





Kansas couple finds there's no place like Gulf Shores

Carol and Roy DeWitt discovered the Gulf Shores, Ala., area in 2014 when looking for a February winter escape.

They have returned each year for several weeks, but this past year made a bigger commitment - buying a Gulf-front condo in nearby Orange Beach.

Roy, 66 and Carol, 67, hail from Overland Park, Kansas – a suburb of Kansas City - and have five children and nine grandchildren. Their children all have successful careers, and in 2011, the couple decided to make their summer home at Lake of the Ozarks in Missouri their full-time residence. Their Orange Beach condo is now their winter residence, family getaway and also used as a vacation rental.

Roy started playing guitar at the age of 12 and turned his passion for music into his career. He (and Carol) owned and managed a large music store for 26 years, which started on a shoestring budget and grew to 10,000 square feet and 500 students per week. Roy retired in 2011 at age 57 after surviving stage 3 colon cancer. He and Carol are strong advocates for colonoscopies.

Carol retired two years ago from her full-time job as a senior manager with a large oncology company so she could help care for her aging mother. She moved in with her during the last six months of her life and said it was "time well spent."

Among her career accomplishments was connecting individuals with free or reduced fee drugs through programs she helped developed with manufacturers and a large insurance company. She also mentored dozens as they, too, built successful careers.

Carol's career involved being a "road warrior," but today she enjoys their home on the lake spending time with Roy fishing and in Orange Beach, the renovation of their 2-bedroom, 2-bath beach condo. The pair also enjoy traveling and sightseeing across the U.S.

During their travels, they discovered the Gulf Coast at Dauphin Island and then migrated east.



Their condo renovation is nearly complete with the second bed and bath still left to do. The couple spends free time exploring the area. They try to attend the weekly winter cooking classes at Rouses Markets, walk and hike local trails, visit attractions such as the Naval Air Museum in Pensacola and attend church in an unconventional setting – the famed southern honky-tonk, the Flora-Bama.

Their new beach condo has proven popular with their children and grandchildren who have vacationed there twice, including in July and October (they also rented a unit below them for the overflow.) They also hope to host friends who winter in Panama City Beach sometime before heading back to

Missouri.

The couple said being a Snowbird should be "everyone's goal." They are enjoying this new phase of life while celebrating aspects of their previous one.

They proudly proclaim their allegiance to their hometown team with "Go Chiefs!"

Pensacola Open: The little PGA tournament that could

Snowbirds who play golf at Perdido Bay Golf Club and Tiger Point Country Club in Gulf Breeze are swinging on two courses that were part of the PGA Tour in the past.

The Pensacola Open was a part of the PGA Tour for 32 years from 1956 until 1988.

The Pensacola Country Club hosted the event until 1977 when it moved to Perdido Bay Country Club, where it hosted the event for the next ten years. Tiger Point hosted the event in the final year. From 1969 to 1974, it was known as the Monsanto Open with a sponsorship from a local company.

A significant milestone occurred in 1974 when Lee Elder won in a playoff over Peter Oosterhuis. That win qualified Elder for The Masters, making him the first black golfer to play in the prestigious event.

tournament's organizer, Jerry Stephens, the executive director of the Pensacola Sports Association, to bring in big names in golf to play, as well as other famous sports figures and entertainers to play in the proam tournament that preceded

tournament play. Athletes included

Willie Mays, Stan Musial, Joe Theismann and Johnny Unitas. Celebrities included Gerald Ford, Glen Campbell, Jimmy Buffet, the Gatlin Brothers and Bob Hope.



"The biggest thing about the Pensacola Open is that it will always be remembered forever in the golf world as the tournament that got Lee Elder into the Masters," said Bill Vilona, who wrote a book on the tournament called "Loud Pants and Tight Lies. The Story of the Pensacola Open."

"Lee won at PCC at a time when he was not permitted inside the clubhouse, and he had to change his shoes in the parking lot. His winning that day was historic and it became a national story."

Other notable winners include Arnold Palmer in 1963 and Gary Player in 1964. Pensacola native Jerry Pate, a U.S. Open winner, won the title in 1981. Vilona said Pate worked with the it was the connections that Jerry Pate and the dogged determination of Jerry Stephens to make it all happen," Vilona said.

When the event was held for ten years at Perdido Bay, it was known as the last-chance open.

"The event was always held in October toward the end of the golf season," Vilona said. "Players who needed to make enough money to get their tour card for the following year would show up. They would always get a strong field because of that."

In 1988, the event moved to Tiger Point, which was owned by Pate and was considered the showplace golf course in the Pensacola area. But after that year, the PGA Tour announced that beginning in 1989, all tournaments would be required to have a minimum purse of \$1 million. The Pensacola Open, whose purse was always less than half that, was no more. "There was no way they do it," Vilona said. "It didn't leave for lack of local support;



they just got priced out of the market. When you think about little ole Pensacola, that was the signature sporting event of Pensacola.

"This was the signature sporting event in town. It happened because of Jerry Pate and Jerry Stephens. The Pensacola Open is an amazing part of sports history here. It's the little tournament that could."






Figure 1: Notice the very small blood vessels surrounding each nerve.




Figure 2: When these very small blood vessels become diseased they begin to shrivel up and the nerves begin to degenerate. The main problem is, you may have been told after trying a number of things, just to live with the problem. There is now a facility right here in Gulf Shores that offers you hope without the side effects that those endless drugs can cause.
