



Michigan couple takes in the whole Gulf Coast

Michigan natives Paul, 67, and Elaine, 63, Cummins-Torres will spend five months along the northern Gulf Coast this winter - just not in the same spot. After spending the holidays (November-December) in the small community of Navarre Beach, they shift to Panama City Beach from January through March. And they take advantage of quality experiences at both. This is their sixth year on the Gulf Coast.

We are drawn to the beach, and to us. there are none more beautiful in the continental US than along the Gulf Coast. The large community of fellow snowbirds and activities, and now having family in the area, keep us coming back.

Tell us about your family.

We have one son, Nathan, his wife,

20; Dominic, 8; and Vincent, 6. After vacationing on the Gulf Coast for a couple of years, our son, his wife and two sons relocated from Michigan to Gulf Breeze in 2020. Our granddaughter, Olivia, resides in Michigan.


Do you have any tips for new Snowbirds?







The region is putting on party hats – and boots to welcome back Snowbirds for what is expected to be the first full season in a, well, few years.




Snowball Derby stock car race


