

Canadian Couple makes Alabama home port for cruise season

Beverley Lee, 72, and Charles Vertes, 77, met aboard a cruise ship pre-Covid with a made-for-television movie-type script. Both are fit and adventuresome with bright, welcoming smiles. This year they are renting a three-bedroom condo at Turquoise in Orange Beach. Here is their story as told by Lee.

Q. Are you married?

(We are) not married. Our spouses passed away several years ago. We met on a transatlantic cruise in November 2019.

Q. Are you still working or retired? I retired as a school principal in 2006, and Charles retired as a McDonald's franchise owner in 2019.

Q. Where are you both from?

I am from Midland, Ontario, and Charles is from Vancouver, British Columbia. We spend our time between our two homes and travel extensively.

Q. Do you have children and grandchildren?

No children for me. Charles has two boys and eight grandchildren – fouryear-old triplets (two girls and a boy), a nine-year-old boy, three teenage girls and a teenage boy.

Q. How did you decide to spend your winter on the Alabama Gulf Coast? Back in 2008, I visited friends here and instantly fell in love with the area. (I)



have been spending winters here since then. (I) stayed at the Beach Club, Fort Morgan, from 2008 until 2020. (I) was active as a volunteer yoga instructor and helped snowbirds with technology. (I) still help with their snowbird Facebook page. (I have) made many friends and keep in touch.

Charles visited in winter 2020. Then, Covid (happened) and we were unable to travel until the fall of 2021. We are thrilled to be back again.

Q. You met on a transatlantic cruise and were both traveling solo? How did that happen?

We both love cruising - a safe and fun way to travel alone. Ship excursions provide numerous opportunities to explore each port. As a woman, I would not have felt confident going to many of these places. Charles and I boarded the ship in Barcelona, Spain.

Charles left after 15 days in Miami, while I continued on the same ship for 15 more days through the Panama Canal and other ports, all the way to San Diego. As an avid boater, it had been my dream to do this repositioning transatlantic cruise.

Q. For those who don't know how cruising works - particularly transatlantic cruises - explain what

attracted you guys to that option. Transatlantic and/or repositioning cruises are usually longer and involve many sea days. Ships are being moved to or from their seasonal locations. We both love days at sea and exploring new destinations not easily available by car, train or plane.

Q. How did Covid affect your relationship?

Our travel plans changed dramatically. We canceled several cruises and missed a winter on the Gulf Coast but enjoyed many Canadian winter activities, including snowshoeing. Our first cruise since Covid was in November out of New Orleans to Mexico and the Western Caribbean. Short cruises are a great way to get started.

Q. Is there anything you wish you

had known about cruising and snowbirding before retirement? No... in my wildest imagination, I did not think retired life could be this amazing. Highly recommend it. Live every day to the fullest.

Q. What kind of activities do vou like to do on the coast? Are there any you miss doing at home? Enjoy symphony and theatre in Gulf Shores, Orange Beach, Pensacola and Mobile. Walking the beautiful beach, local trails and practicing yoga are my favorite activities. Charles loves golf. He participates in the Iowa-Alabama Snowbird Golf Club group several times a week. We both love trying new

restaurants, especially seafood. The Gulf, Cosmos, Acme (and) Cobalt are long-time favorites. Both our homes are on the water, but we miss the sights and sounds of the Gulf, the beautiful quartz sand and fresh seafood from Joe Patti's in Pensacola.

Q. What are your favorite places to go? Any new ones?

Love Fairhope, Pensacola, New Orleans and the National Seashore between Gulf Breeze and Navarre.

Q. Do you have out-of-town visitors during your stay?

Yes, over the years, (we) have had many visitors for a week's stay. Since Covid, no. Most Canadians find it too difficult to fly here and are not keen on the cool temps.



Q. Do you ever take side trips to and from the coast?

No! Usually, (we) can't wait to get here. (We) normally drive down from Toronto in two or three days. (We) often stop in Niagara Falls, Nashville and/or Birmingham.

This time, we did a cruise out of NOLA before our vacation. (We) loved doing cruises from Mobile to Mexico. Usually (we) took at least one a winter. (We're) looking forward to them being back in Mobile. We are doing another cruise from Jacksonville to the Bahamas in January and will likely visit friends in Florida before and afterward.






