



# Activities Energize Walton Snowbird Club Membership

Walton club Board members such as Peg and Bob Breetz took on the challenge of rebuilding the club's membership roster by finding help, adding activities - and building a social media presence. The results are in the stats: The Walton County Snowbirds currently have 627 members, with 131 new members this year. As a retiree and snowbird, you may get tired of being asked, "what do you do all day?" The Walton County Snowbirds have so many activities that our calendars are pretty busy! Some of our more physical activities include aerobics, line dancing, water aerobics, and Zumba.

Snowbird aerobics is every Monday and Wednesday at 10 a.m. at Legion Park in good weather or Faith Fellowship Hall in bad weather. Both locations are in Miramar Beach. Peg Breetz, the instructor, says they get an average of 40-50 members per class, but there is plenty of room to spread out. The members enjoy doing the class at



Legion Park, right on Choctawhatchee Bay. The class combines low-impact cardio-intensive moves and all body strength and conditioning using light weights and body weight.

Line dancing is from 11:15 a.m. to 12:15 p.m. every Monday and Wednesday at Faith Fellowship Hall, Miramar Beach. Several of the aerobics members head to line dancing right after aerobics for a fun, music-based workout. Instructor Sarah Vaillancourt breaks the dances into basic steps. Members learn a new dance each week to music styles, including country, pop, rock and hiphop.

Sarah also holds water aerobics sessions on Tuesdays and Thursdays at Hidden Dunes at 11 a.m. The pool is heated! The group does a variety of water aerobic exercises with a noodle and also strengthening and toning. Contact Sarah through the waltoncountysnowbirds.com website if you are interested in the class.

Senior Zumba is held on Wednesdays at 3 p.m. at Faith Fellowship Hall. Zumba is led by local instructor Jane McGee. A variety of music gets the group dancing! Each class is \$4.

There are over 30 more activities, including basketball, bowling, golf, discussion groups, singles group, excursions and more. The club has very active card groups, including bridge, hand and foot, poker and euchre.

The renewal ceremonies started 15 years ago at Lulu's in Gulf Shores to give the community something fun to do for Valentine's Day. In 2020, the last renewal ceremonies before Covid, 307 couples renewed their vows in Gulf Shores while 172 couples participated in Destin.

"It is so sweet to see couples who have been married for decades look into each other's eyes and fall in love again," Barnett said. "I walk around and take photos during the event and get very teary-eyed. The energy on the beach is full of love."

While locals are welcome and do participate, she said most in attendance are typically snowbirds.

"The snowbird temporary population is incredibly important to our coastal communities in the January-to-spring break months," Barnett added. "They bring a much-needed influx of business to the rental companies, local stores and restaurants. They keep us going before the spring break, and summer tourists arrive."





# Enjoy the original Mardi Gras and new traditions in Mobile, Ala.

Most people outside the region think New Orleans is the home of the original Mardi Gras. Actually, that claim to fame belongs to Mobile, Ala.

Both cities were once the capital of French (Catholic) Louisiana – and each at one time was under Spain's rule. But Mobile has the distinction of having staged the first celebration in 1711. The first mystic societies developed some 120 years later.

Over the years, regional Mardi Gras celebrations have been challenged by many events (including the





aftermath of numerous hurricanes), but celebrants have found a way. The Covid-19 pandemic and resulting restrictions and lockdowns presented a unique challenge. Still, Mobile

residents were not to be deterred and began creating float replicas in 2021 on their expansive front porches - and lawns (hence the term Yardi Gras.) That way, celebrants could drive by

and participate safely from a distance. And local businesses heavily invested in Mardi Gras still had an income stream. Local charities also benefit.

The Porch Parades continue today and may become a new tradition!



# Women's monument joins myriad vet memorials along coast

For the last 12 years, a dedicated group of volunteers in Pensacola has worked to establish a permanent monument to an arguably overlooked group of selfless servants – women who have served their country in uniform.

"The Monument to Women Veterans will recognize, empower and honor the military women who have served their country and often provide unmet critical resources for female veteran care," said Jennifer Harrison, a volunteer with the monument. An estimated 2.8 million women veterans have honorably served in combat since 1948.

The monument will reach more than 35 feet in the air with flames, with a laser beam over a stainless-steel elliptical band of water. The monument will be surrounded by women figures from each branch of the military in their service uniforms.

World-renowned sculptor Elizabeth MacQueen has been selected to create the piece of art.

The project took a major leap forward when organizers signed a 100-year lease for the old Amtrak station at 980 E. Heinberg Street in Downtown Pensacola. The sculpture will be installed outside of the station and the building will become a museum, visitor center and veterans resource facility. Fundraising for the \$2.5 million renovation project is ongoing.

The museum opened in November 2021.

"We currently host the Wounded Eagle UAS Drone Training Program, Defenders of Freedom Florida, NetSimple, and FAVOB," Harrison said. "There are UWF Historical Women Veteran Images there now, as well."

Ultimately, the facility will offer women veterans help in areas like post-traumatic stress, military sexual trauma, traumatic brain issues, domestic violence, unemployment and homelessness.

With the many military bases along the northern Gulf Coast, there are numerous monuments and memorials peppered across our communities marking the accomplishments and sacrifice of the nation's warriors, including these:

Veterans Tribute Tower, 316 Beal Pkwy NW, Fort Walton Beach, Fla. (Beal Memorial Cemetery) For more than 30 years, the Fort



gathered on the entrance green to Beal Memorial Cemetery on solemn occasions to honor the veterans interred there.

Then, about a decade ago, a group of local citizens came together to design, fund and construct a new focal point on the site, the Veterans Tribute
Tower. The 30-foot tall, four-faced clock tower with the Freedom Bell and Carillon was inaugurated with a Veterans Day ceremony in 2015.
Now, the memorial is home to annual Veterans Day and Memorial Day commemorations, as well as other remembrances, said Tom Rice, chairman of the Veterans Tribute Tower Committee.



"November brings the ringing of the Freedom Bell as names are read for the Lazarus Field internments, and December features the Wreaths Across America Placement Ceremony," said Rice, who owns Magnolia Grill in Fort Walton Beach.

"In addition to the planned ceremonies, the Freedom Bell and Carillon 'Taps' are utilized upon request by numerous families as services are held for loved ones."

Rice, a retired first sergeant and member of the Florida Veterans Hall of Fame, believes the tower has already become a place of genuine reflection.



"Shortly after the Veterans Tribute
Tower was dedicated, a young military
spouse had lost her husband after
his very difficult struggle with brain
cancer," he said. "She told me that
she found great comfort visiting the
Tower green and reading the message
on the four clockfaces, 'Take Time
To Remember,' and remembering the
good times before her spouse's tragic
passing."

Beal Memorial Cemetery is the final resting place for more than 1,800 veterans.

## USS Alabama Battleship Memorial Park, 2703 Battleship Parkway, Mobile, Ala.

Although anchored by the battleship and other armaments, the USS Alabama Battleship Memorial Park is also home to several memorials, including specific monuments for veterans of Korea and Vietnam – including a standing POW bracelet – and a memorial to service members who died in the line of duty since 9/11, among others.

Mississippi Vietnam Veterans
Memorial, 3704 Bienville Blvd, Ocean
Springs, Miss. (on the grounds of
the Ocean Springs Civic Center)
This memorial consists of two black
granite walls facing each other,
bearing the names and faces of
the 668 Mississippians who died in
Vietnam. The site also includes the
main mast from the USS Mississippi
and the USS Tullibee Memorial - The

## USS Biloxi Memorial, 693 Beach Boulevard, Biloxi, Miss. (Biloxi Small Craft Harbor, next to Hard Rock Casino)

Submarine Veterans of WWII display.

This monument includes the World War II-era light cruiser's superstructure, a Purple Heart display and other war-related markers.


## Navarre Black Hawk Memorial, 8593 Navarre Pkwy Navarre, Fla. (Navarre Park)

On March 10, 2015, four Louisiana National Guardsmen and seven Marines died on a training exercise when their Black Hawk helicopter crashed into Santa Rosa Sound near Navarre. With many military families living in Navarre, the community was especially touched by the tragedy. They worked together to establish this memorial, which features a sculpture of a large eagle in flight as well as a sign that lists the service members' names and a plaque explaining the crash.



The Wall South, 200 S. 10th Ave. Pensacola, Fla. (Admiral Mason Park) This monument is a half-scale replica of the Vietnam Memorial in

# What is AFib, and How Can it Affect Your Health

Atrial fibrillation, or AFib, is when the upper chambers of the heart (atria) quiver or flutter. This irregular beating causes the blood to move inefficiently through your heart. If you feel a fluttering sensation in your throat, neck or chest while performing your daily activities, it could indicate that a visit with your physician is needed. Men and women should not ignore these heart flutters.

While AFib is not usually lifethreatening, it can increase your risk of stroke and heart disease. Some of the following AFib symptoms can significantly impact your quality of life:

- Anxiety
- Shortness of breath
- Weakness
- Chronic fatigue
- Lightheadedness/dizziness
- Rapid or irregular heartbeats
- Swelling of the lower extremities

Decreased stamina

"AFib is a common heart rhythm disturbance," said Thabet Alsheikh, M.D., FACC, FHRS, electrophysiologist at Baptist Heart & Vascular Institute. "It has a variety of symptoms. Many patients never know they have it. The most concerning thing is the risk of having a stroke. That's why talking to a doctor and seeking treatment for AFib is essential."

According to American College of Cardiology Foundation researchers, the likelihood of developing AFib increases with age. Other factors can also increase a person's risk of developing AFib, such as family history, heart disease, high blood pressure, obesity, alcohol consumption and other chronic conditions.




